



TOURNAMENT FORMAT FOR FUND-RAISING PURPOSES

Tournaments

5vs5™ The Canadian City Challenge! offers many different possibilities as to objective, format, number of cities involved and number of board games needed.

Some examples follow:

Objectives

Many organizations can use the tournament as a social or fund-raising activity.

5vs5 Celebrity Tournament for CHEO

5vs5 Optimist Club Tournament

5vs5 United Way Tournament

5vs5 Rockland High School District Tournament

Format

A tournament may be held simultaneously as the First Official Super Tournament, but variations are also possible.

Tournament play can be spread out during a weekend or even a week.

Some games are then played simultaneously, some one after the other.

Number of Cities Involved

Variations can be made for number of cities involved.

128 cities 4 rounds 128/ 32/ 8/ 4

64 cities 3 rounds 64/ 16/ 4

32 cities 3 rounds 32/ 8/ 4

16 cities 2 rounds 16/ 4

Board games needed for a tournament

A tournament may be held with only 1 game board but could take several hours.

Tournaments may be organized better with 4, 8, 16 or 32 board games.

Tournament Kits
